



### **Try-Outs & Recruitment Periods**

Subject to the policies established by the recognized member districts or the Wisconsin Youth Soccer Association where applicable.

Tryouts shall be held in accordance with the district tryout policies or those established by the WYSA Board of Directors for selected districts.

Players must be notified within three days of the last scheduled (and advertised) tryout indicating whether or not an offer to join the team will be made. Players, upon notification that an offer to join a team has been made, have up to five days to accept or reject the offer to join a team. After the five day period from notification has lapsed, the team is able to pursue other players or the team may hold a spot for a player.

Once a player submits a completed registration form and/or submits a deposit with the intent to play within a club, that player is obligated to that club for the registration year intended. For the purposes of which team a player first committed, the date (and time if applicable) on the registration form determines which club a player is obligated to for the registration year intended. (i.e., If a player attends three different club tryouts, and receives three different offers, and submits three different registration forms and fees, the earliest date determines which team the player is obligated to for the intended registration year.)

For Southeast Wisconsin (Ozaukee, Waukesha, Milwaukee, Racine, Kenosha and Washington Counties) tryouts for:

- U14 and younger boys and girls may begin the 1st Monday in June.
- U15 and older boys and girls may begin the last Monday in June (revised 10/18/08, effective 09-10 playing season).

### **Recruiting Violations**

There may be no personal contact with players for recruiting of players before the allowable tryout periods as established by the member districts. This means the player and/or family members cannot be contacted in any way before the published tryout dates. Coaches may be suspended from coaching and/or the team may be prevented from playing in sanctioned activities if violations of the recruiting restriction are confirmed. Recruiting and tryouts end 30 days before the start of the season or if a player has signed with a team. (modified November 10, 2001)
